Children will nap in the living room of the home daycare, an electronic monitor will be used when caregivers are out of the napping room.

In addition, If/when the caregiver(s) is/are not in the room, check-ins will be conducted at 15 minute intervals.

Caregiver(s) will not leave the floor where care is given nor the property for any reason.

Children up to 24 months of age will sleep in a pack-n-play. Children over the age of 24 months will sleep on a mat/cot.

Per NYS regulations;

415.13(b)(5)(xii) Sleeping arrangements for infants through 12 months of age require the infant be placed flat on his or her back to sleep, unless medical information from the child's health care provider is presented to the program by the caretaker that shows that arrangement is inappropriate for that child.

415.13(b)(5)(xiii) Cribs, bassinets and other sleeping areas for infants through 12 months of age must include an appropriately sized fitted sheet, and must not have bumper pads, toys, stuffed animals, blankets, pillows, wedges or infant positioners. Wedges or infant positioners will be permitted with medical documentation from the child's health care provider.
